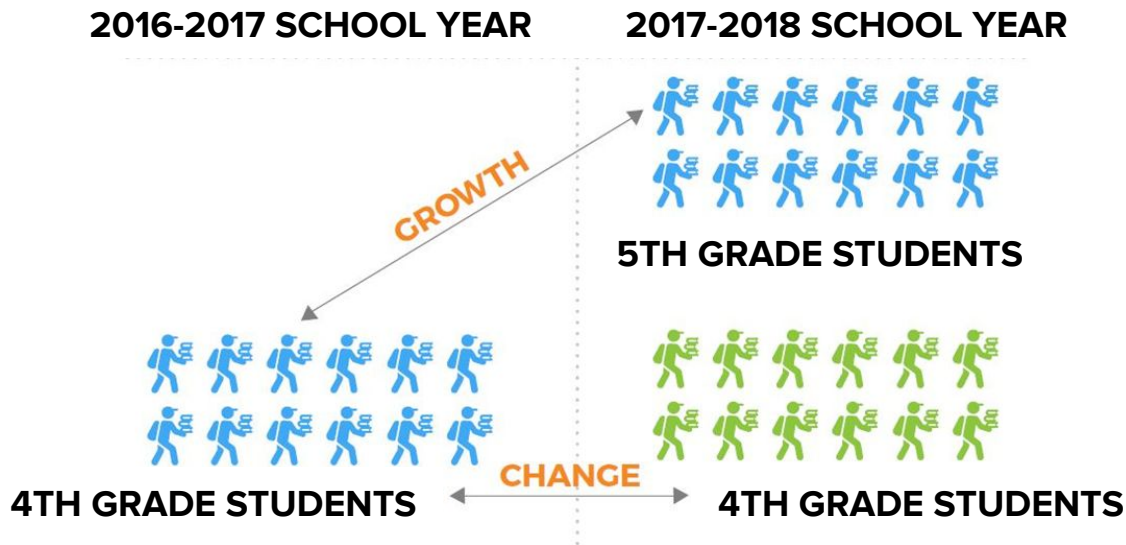

Change: Comparing Year over Year Performance

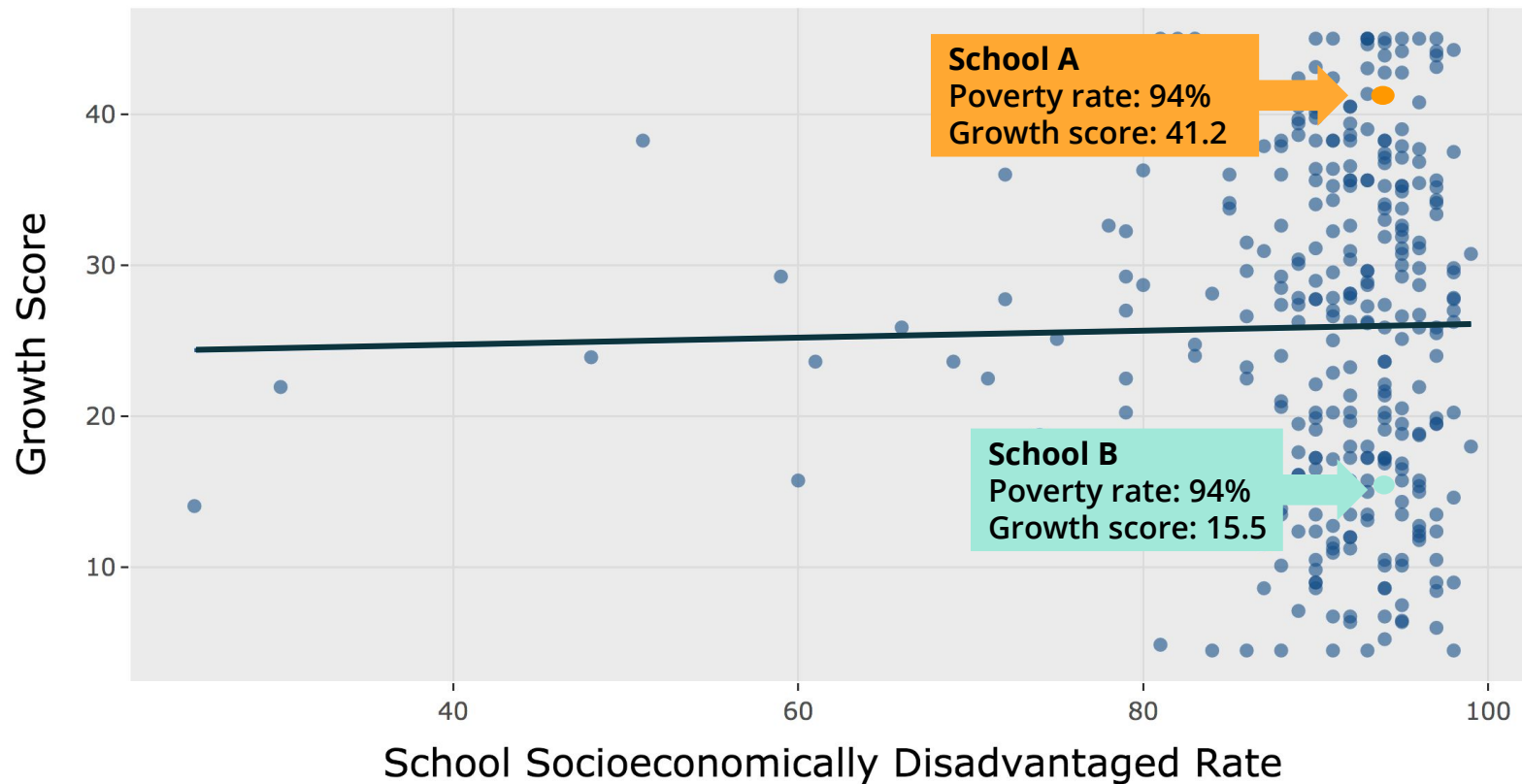
Compares how different students performed from one year to the next on the same tests
