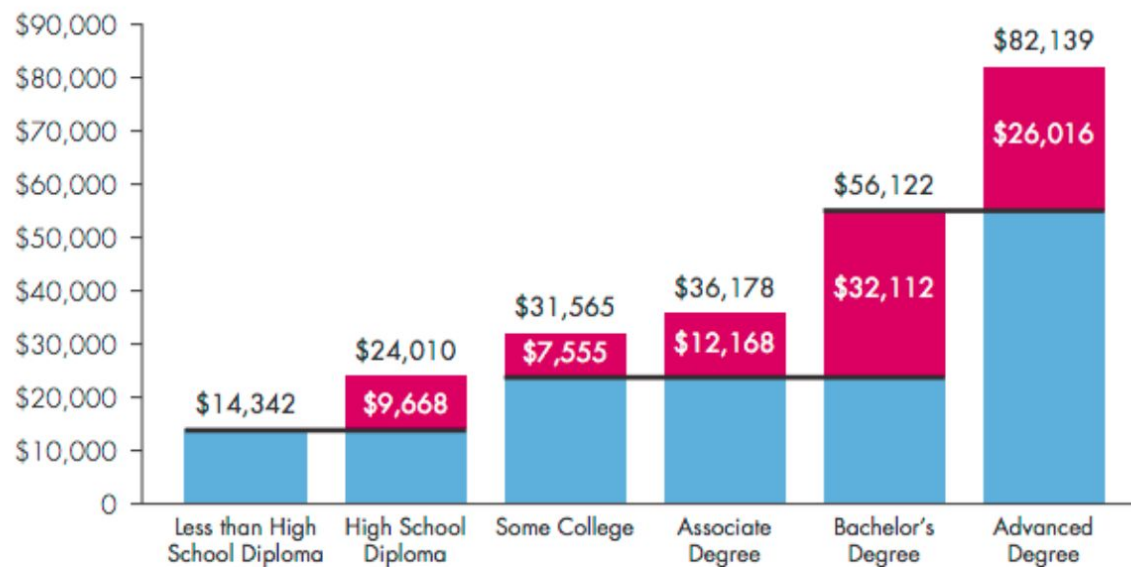

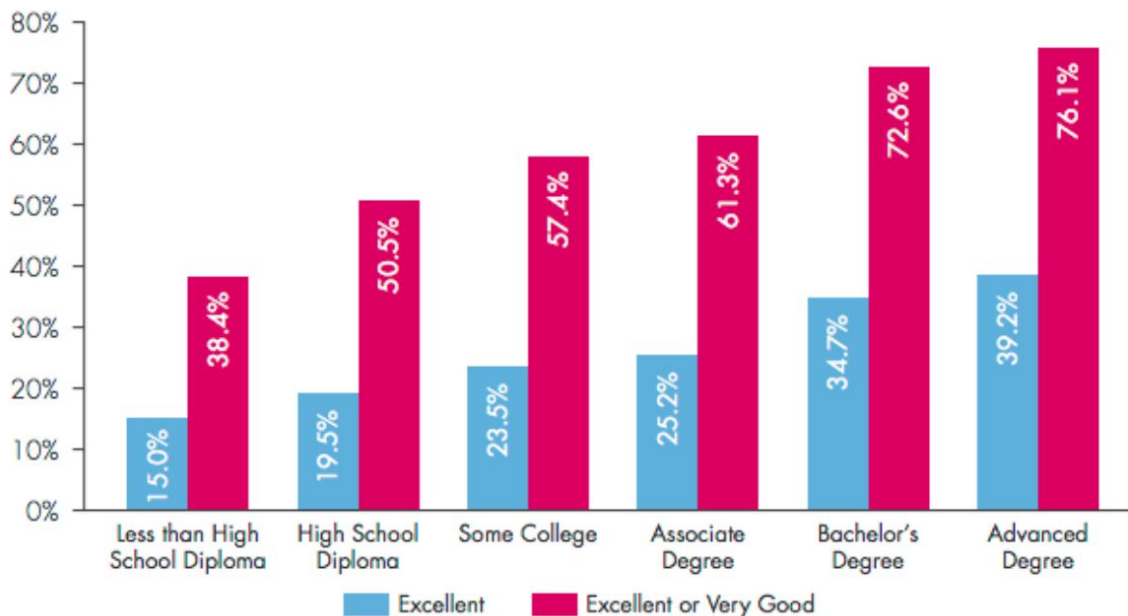
## Average Annual Earnings

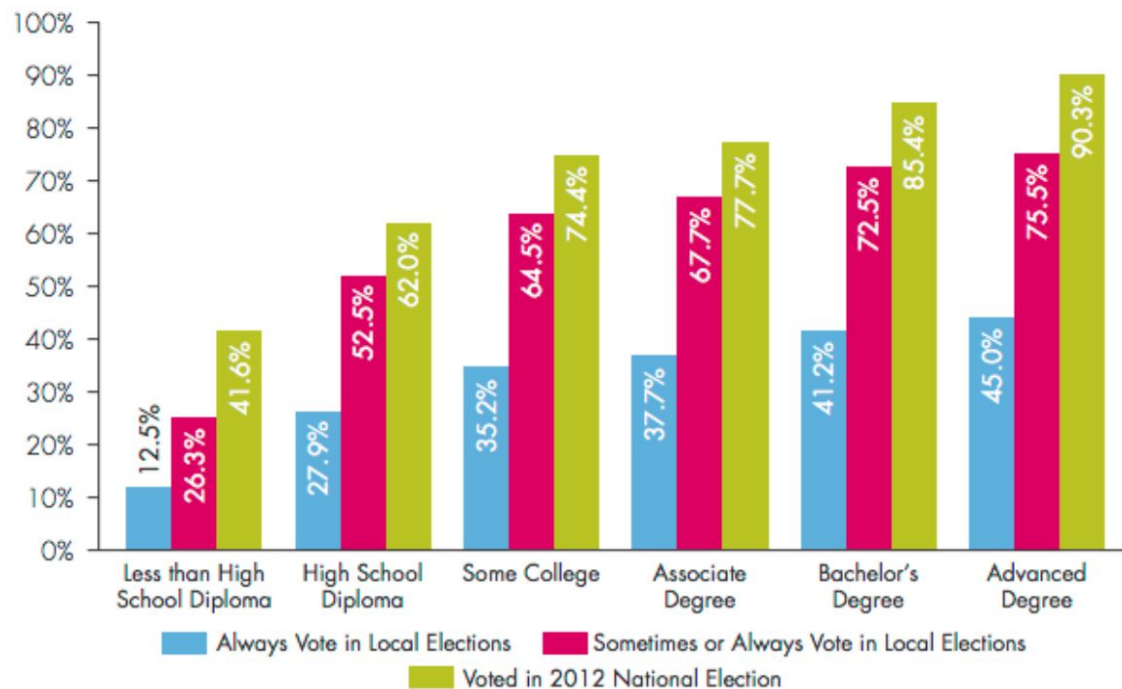


## Self-Reported Health

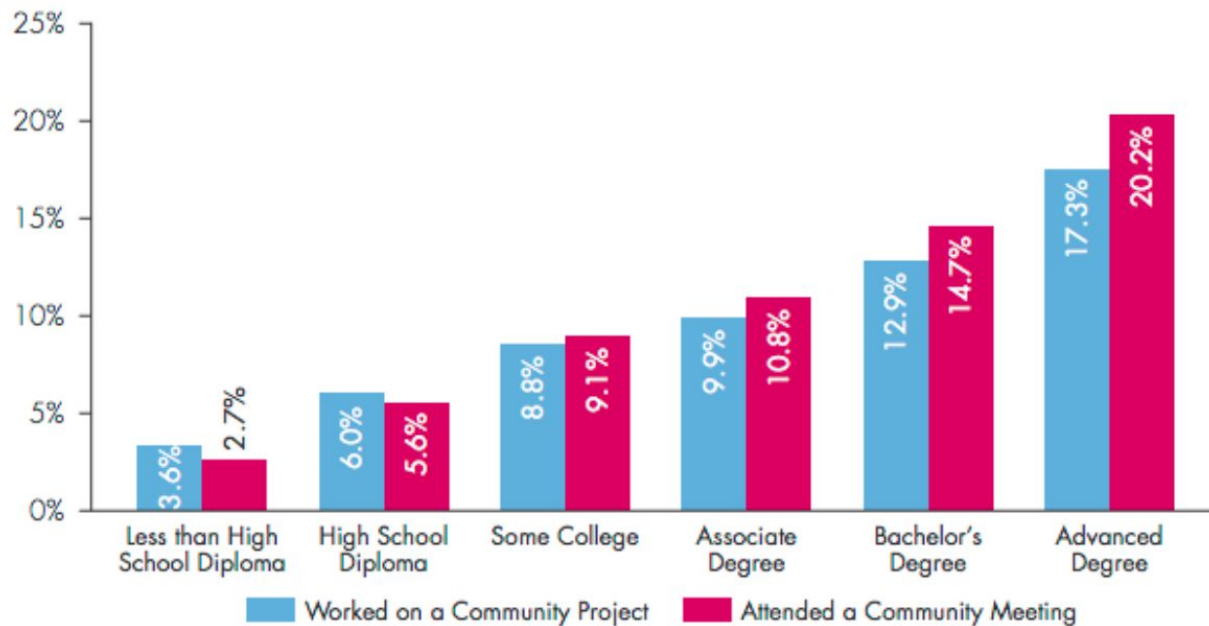

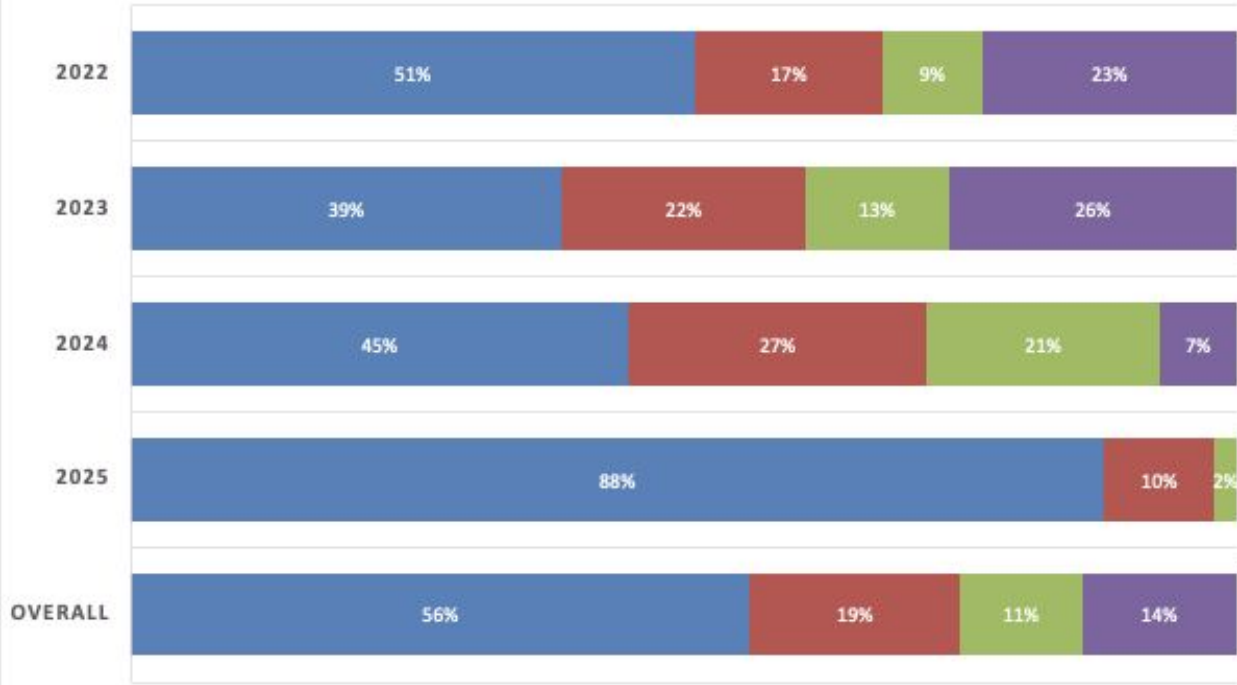
